Herb Roasted Chicken & Vegetables

From: Campbell's Kitchen

Prep: 15 minutes Roast: 50 minutes

Serves: 4

Chicken and vegetables roast together in a creamy sauce to make a dish that's easy, hearty and delicious.

They can usually be found in upscale grocery stores or farmers' markets. "Baby-cut" carrots are mature carrots that have been peeled and cut into small carrot-shaped pieces. They are widely available year round in the produce section of most grocery stores.
