## Calico Beans

This recipe gets its name from the varied colors of the three types of beans that make up this dish.

- ½ lb. ground beef
- 1 c. onion, chopped
- ½ lb bacon, crisply cooked and crumbled in sauce
- 2 (16-oz) cans kidney beans, Drained and rinsed
- 15 ¼ oz can lima beans, drained and rinsed
- ½ c. catsup
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- ¼ c. brown sugar packed
- 1 t. salt
- 3 (16-oz) cans baked beans
- 1 t. dry mustard
- 2 t. white vinegar

1. In a skillet over med heat, cook beef, onion and garlic, until beef is no longer pink; drain.
2. Combine beef mixture, bacon, beans and remaining ingredients in a 3 quart casserole dish. Bake, covered, at 350 degrees for 45 min.

Makes 6-8 servings.
