**Lemon Cheesecake Pies**



**Ingredients**

1 can (12 ounces) evaporated milk  
2 packages (3 ounces *each*) lemon gelatin  
2 cups boiling water  
Lemon Cheesecake Pies (continued)

**Ingredients (continued)**

1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, cubed  
1 tablespoon lemon juice  
1 cup sugar  
4 graham cracker crusts (9 inches)

**TOPPING:**

1 cup graham cracker crumbs  
1/4 cup butter, melted  
2 tablespoons sugar

**Directions**

Pour milk into a large metal bowl; cover and refrigerate for at least 2 hours. In a large bowl, dissolve gelatin in boiling water. Cool for 10 minutes.

Add cream cheese and lemon juice; beat until blended.

Set aside. Beat chilled milk until soft peaks form.

Gradually add sugar. Beat in gelatin mixture.

Pour into crusts. Combine topping ingredients; sprinkle over pies. Refrigerate for 4 hours or until set.

Yield: 4 pies (8 slices each).
