The 2019 Yenko/SC Corvette Stage II is absurd, and it's available at your hometown Chevy dealer. In the 1960s, Pennsylvania dealer Yenko Chevrolet became famous for offering big-block Camaros before even Chevy itself did. The dealership closed in the early 1980s, but the name lives on with pride in cars like this, the 2019 Yenko/SC Corvette Stage II. It's the creation of Specialty Vehicle Engineering (SVE) in Tom's River, New Jersey, and with 1000 hp and 875 lb-ft of torque on tap, it's thoroughly ridiculous.

## Corvette Racing:

### This Is the Mid-Engine Corvette Race Car, Here's what Chevy will use to challenge the Ford GT.

Rumors of Corvette's new C8.R race car being readied to test at Road America were confirmed on Wednesday as the replacement for the aging C7.R broke cover in the Kettle Moraine valley.

Although unconfirmed, the exhaust note emitting from the camouflaged C8.R around the 4.0-mile road course is said to be unlike the renowned, rumbling V8 found in all of its predecessors. It was suggested a twin-turbo V6 could be fitted to the first production-based mid-engine Corvette race car, though the road car is expected to receive a V8.
