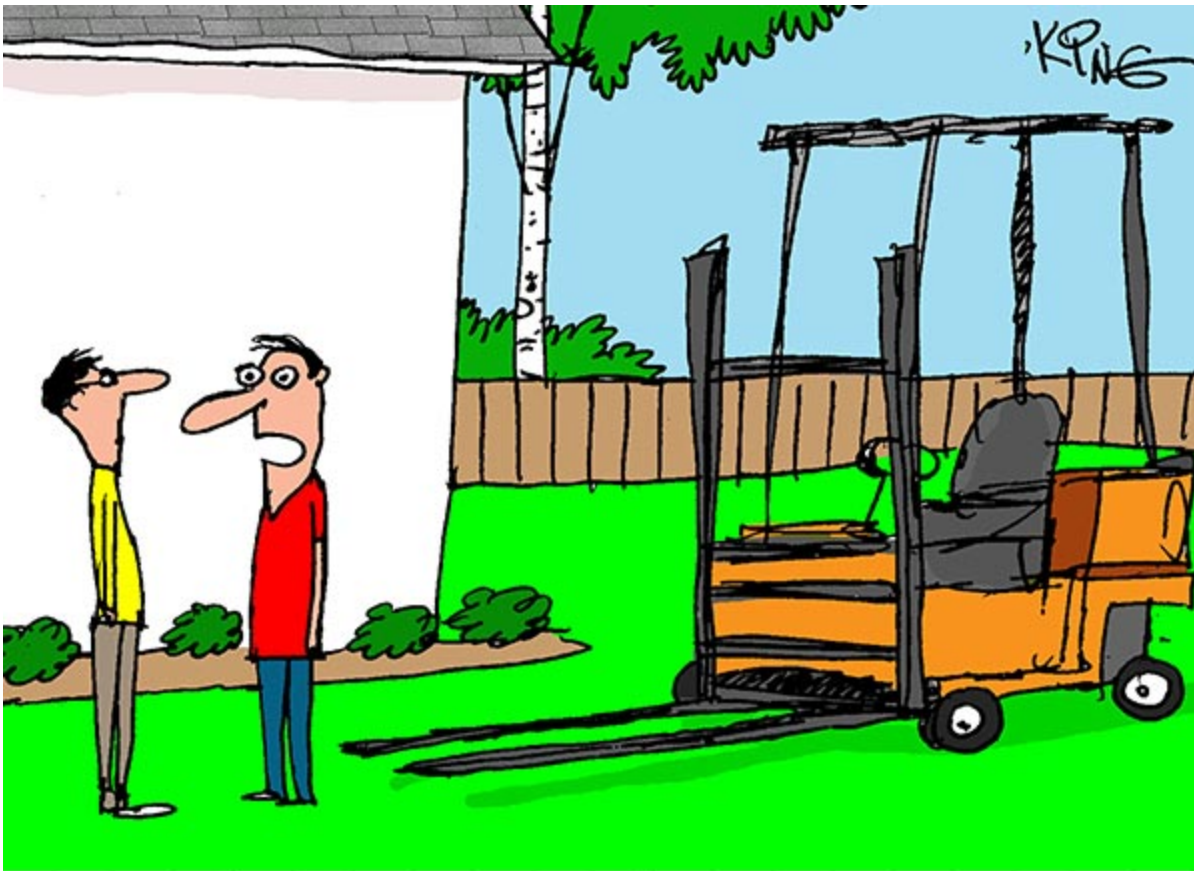
- John Hertog has volunteered to be the newsletter editor. Thank you John!
